General Tournament Information

OVERVIEW

The BMWGA Women's Only Tournament is a 2-day 36-Hole Stroke Play Tournament played in accordance with current USGA Rules of Golf except as modified by local rules or the Tournament Committee. All participants will play by the same rules, from the forward tees whether competitive, sassy senior or noncompetitive.

The tournament will be played on Port Royal Barony and Robber's Row Courses. Winners will be announced and prizes awarded at the awards luncheon immediately following Round 2 on Friday, June 6th, 2025.

INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION

The competitor with the lowest 2-day gross score will be the Gross Tournament Champion and the player with the lowest 2-day net score will be the Low Net Tournament Champion. The gross and net champion will be lifted from their flight and 3 prizes awarded in each flight, 1st through 3rd place.

STATE COMPETITION

All states with at least 5 participants in the competitive or sassy senior divisions are eligible to compete in the "Friendly Fire" State Competition. Competitive state scores will be published after Round 1 to allow our state competitors to know where their group stands going into Round 2.

FLIGHTS

Participants are flighted and paired based on division of play - competitive, sassy senior or non-competitive.

Non-Competitive - All participants for the non-competitive division are paired randomly as handicap is not required. Awards are given based on scorecard drawing. The chance of winning is increased by submitting a scorecard for both days. Scores will not be tallied.

Competitive and Sassy Seniors – Participants are flighted by division and handicap index within each division. Handicap index as of May 15, 2025 is used to determine eligible handicap with a maximum index of 40.

PAIRINGS

Pairings for Day 1 are based on handicap. Pairings for Day 2 will be based on Day 1 results.

An individual's score for Day 1 and Day 2 is combined to determine champions and flight winners. If there is a tie, it will be broken by a second day scorecard playoff using USGA recommendation of 9-6-3-1. Last 9 (10-18), then last 6 (13-18), then last 3 (16-18), then last hole. This method is preconfigured in Golf Genius.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to re-flight a golfer if there is a significant difference in scores relative to their handicap and assigned flight. Please keep in mind that every effort is made to make this tournament as fair as possible, fun for all, and to allow everyone an opportunity to win.

PROXIMITY PRIZES

All participants, competitive, sassy senior and non-competitive will compete for proximity prizes including Long Drive and Closest to the Pin. Contest holes will be announced at the Tournament.

SCORECARDS

Players should exchange score cards with an opponent in your group. The scorekeeper will sign the card. The golfer should double check the score before also signing the card. Turn in all signed cards to the Pro Shop. Once the card is turned in no changes will be made. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Please be advised that the BMWGA website will provide up to date information on any changes due to weather forecast or other unusual situations. Players will also receive a text message or email notification.

For inclement weather during play, players will be notified by the staff at Port Royal on how to proceed.

RULES OF PLAY

- 1. Play under and in accordance with current USGA Rules of Golf except as modified by local rules or the Tournament Committee. Please review USGA rules prior to the event: <u>USGA Rules of Golf Home</u>
- 2.All participants will play by the same rules including non-competitive.
- 3.Play the ball as it lies, Rule 9.1usga <u>Rule 9 Ball Played as It Lies; Ball at Rest Lifted</u> <u>or Moved</u>
- 4.Ball in penalty areas (bodies of water or other areas as defined by the committee) is played in accordance with Rule 17 <u>Rule 17 Penalty Areas</u>
- 5. In accordance with Rule 21.2 Maximum Score, the tournament Committee has capped the maximum score on any hole as double par plus 1 for all players. - <u>Rule 21 - Other</u> <u>Forms of Individual Stroke Play and Match Play</u>
- 6. Alternate to Stroke and Distance Penalty Applicable for Lost Ball or Ball Out of Bounds. Under penalty of two strokes, player can take relief by dropping the original ball or another ball in the designated area of relief at the nearest fairway edge, no closer to the hole. - <u>Stroke and Distance: New Local Rule</u>
- 7.Cell phone usage during competition is limited to tournament related functions (i.e. GPS, Rules of Golf, Golf Genius, etc.) and emergency situations. Your phone must be on silent during the competition.
- 8. The following will result in player disqualification:
 - a.Failure to report to designated tee box at starting time
 - b.Failure to exchange scorecard at the beginning of play
 - c.Playing a hole out of sequence
 - d.Failure to sign scorecard or signing incorrect scorecard
 - e.Leaving the course without turning in a scorecard
- 9. If there is any doubt as to procedure, play a second ball; announce you are hitting a second ball and which one you will score if allowed. Request a ruling prior to attesting scorecard.
- 10. All golfers should direct questions to the Golf Pro or designated Rule Official for any rules questions during the tournament or make note of your question and check in with the Golf Pro before signing and turning in your scorecard.
- 11. Please avoid slow play. Marshalls will be actively on the course to help facilitate pace of play

PACE OF PLAY

- Play "Ready Golf".
- Keep up with the group in front of you.
- Pick up after double par plus 1 (maximum score established under Rule 21.2).
- Be ready to play when it is your turn to play.
- Do not search more than the permitted 3 minutes for a potentially lost ball.
- Plan your shot while walking to your ball or while others are playing.
- Take several clubs with you to your ball so you won't have to walk back to the cart.
- Line up your putt when others are putting
- A player should take not more than 40 seconds to make a stroke after the player is able to play without interference or distractions.
- Play 2 balls if uncertain of correct procedure. Report facts to the tournament director or designated rules person before turning in scorecard.
- Play a provisional ball if you think the original might be lost outside a penalty area or out of bounds.
- Consider leaving the flagstick in the hole when putting (no penalty if the ball hits the flagstick).
- Exit the green promptly after holing out. Record scores and replace clubs at the next teeing area.
